



- Lenawee Great Start Social Emotional Work Group Meeting Minutes  
August 2, 2011      Tecumseh Public Library      11:00 pm - 12:30 pm
- Members Present:

  - Kay Barber, Lenawee Great Start
- Kay updated the group on the ASQ-3 & ASQ-SE trainings that are currently going on:
  - 10 people completed the ASQ-3 training so far.
  - 6 people have completed the ASQ-SE trainings so far.
  - There are 3 training sessions left in the month of August.
  - The trainings are based on the paper version of the ASQ. Great Start is planning on procuring an IPAD for the free screenings and an additional training on how to use the program on the IPAD will probably be necessary.  
Note: If screenings take place *without* an IPAD we may need to make sure we have access to a copier on site in case we run low on paper copies of the screenings.
- The group discussed who we should approach to volunteer to do the free screenings.
  - Kay will be making Great Start presentations to service clubs in September and October. She will ask for volunteers to help screen children at these meetings.
  - Cary brought contact information for the Program Director of Counseling Education at both the Graduate and Undergraduate levels at Siena Heights University, the Department Chair of the Social Work department at Adrian College as well as the office manager of JCC's Adrian campus. Kay Barber will contact these people regarding the possibility of students in these

programs volunteering to screen children with the ASQ tool when school resumes in the fall.

- Kay will follow up with Tara regarding the possibility of professionals volunteering from Promedica.
- The group decided that we would focus on the above groups first and then follow up with churches later in the fall. Cary is going to touch base with some members of her church for us.
- The group also discussed what locations we should focus on having the first set of screenings.
  - It was decided that locations where parents and children are waiting for an appointment would work well, especially in a place without “fun stuff” going on.
  - The WIC office and car seat checks were the top two suggestions; Kay Barber will follow up with the WIC office and Safe Kids about the possibility of doing screenings at these locations.
  - Other events/ locations mentioned: the Lenawee Home School Association meetings in Tecumseh, local Parks & Recreation events, Hayes State Park Halloween event in October, Health Department Immunization / Family planning clinics & Meijer’s Baby Week event, the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in September.
- LGS will advertise the additional trainings and subsequent trainings offered when we attend events in the community. Kay will also follow up with trainees who have completed training when emailing them their certificate of completion, asking them to volunteer to do free screenings.
- Kay is to look into whether a group of retired school teachers exists - this may be a group to engage in the trainings and free screenings.
- It was suggested that if a screening was going to be held for 4 hours that we may want to break up volunteers into shifts of 1-2 hours.
- The Lenawee Great Start Social/Emotional workgroups meetings for the 2011-2012 year will be at 11am on the following days: October 4, 2011, December 6, 2011, February 7, 2012, April 3, 2012, August 7, 2012 at the *PORTER EDUCATION CENTER*, 2946 Sutton Rd.
